

The now regular Wednesday night event with a grading limit was amended so that the highest grade is 1600 FIDE rather than 1500. This allowed myself (graded 1517) and a couple of others to enter. In all 21 players entered, a good turn out, for the 6 round swiss tournament with 10 minutes on the clock.

After the first 3 rounds Iulia Covaci from Romania and yours truly led the field having won our opening 3 games and we met in round 4 with myself as white and we pick up the game after Iulia has just played 16. ...Rc8 (see diagram). This game me an opportunity to gain an advantage - can you see it?

I played 17. Nxf6+ Bxf6 18. Bxf6 Qxf6 19. Bxa6 bxa6 20. Qxd7 effectively winning a pawn Rfd8 21. Qb7 Ne7 22. Rxc8 Rxc8 23. Qxa6 winning another pawn Qc3 24. b5 Nd5 25. b6 Rb8 26. b7 Qc7 27. Rb1 Kh7 28. Nd4 Ne7 29. a4 e5 30. Qd3+ g6 31. Nb5 Qxb7 and black wins back one of the pawns 32. Nc3 Qc7 33. Rxb8 Qxb8 34. Qb5 Qc7 35. Qb2 Qd7 36. h3 Nd5 37. Nxd5 Qxd5 and with time running out I am trying to press home my advantage.

Play continued 38. Qb5 Qd1+ 39. Kh2 Qd6 40. e4 Qf6 41. Kg1 Qf4 42. Qd5 Qc1+ 43. Kh2 Qf4+ 44. Kg2 and it looked like Iulia was going to escape with a draw. However, she noticed that my clock had run down and played 44. ...Kg7 as my flag dropped.

I won the rest of my games to finish of 5 out of 6, Iulia also beat Paul Fischer but lost in round 5 to Herman Kok so there was a 3 way for first place between Iulia, Paul and myself with Iulia declared the winner as she had beaten the other two.
